DIRECTIONS:

FROM LAKELAND DRIVE:

From I-55 take Lakeland Drive to Highway 471 Exit (Goshen Springs Exit). Turn left onto 471 and travel until you get to Highway 43. Turn left (west) and go until you see the signs.

FROM THE NATCHEZ TRACE:

Enter the Natchez Trace at the I-55 North intersection and travel east. Take the Highway 43 exit off the Trace and turn right onto Highway 43. Turcotte Lab is less than one mile on the left. Signs will be posted.
